Annual CO₂ emissions per capita in metric tons: 4.8

Most important industries:

- Machinery, Shipbuilding and automotive
- Tourism
- Metallurgy & defence
- Textile

Individual specialities:

- More severely affected by rising temperatures
- Large potential for solar power
- Hydropower causes issues with neighbours due to dams stopping the flow of rivers
- Very relaxed environmental regulations

Impact of Global Warming:

- Heat waves & droughts
- Dwindling water supply
- Forest fires
- Increased soil erosion

Current Governmental Policies:

- Ratified the Paris Agreement only in 2021
- Coal remains heavily subsidised
- Climate change not properly understood in the wider public
- Slow-walking anti-climate change legislation due to claimed low historic responsibility
