## Myanmar

Ever since the beginning of the Rohingya crisis in 2017, Uzbekistan was among the countries calling Myanmar to stop the aggression against Musims. The government provided humanitarian aid to over 50 thousands refugees hosted in Bangladesh, however Uzbekistan itself is not in position to host refugees. After the coup of 2021 Uzbekistan supported UNSC calls to stop violence all around Myanmar and has not recognized Junta to be the legitimate governing body of Myanmar.
